

QUERIED PERFORMANCES

The following excerpts, taken from the official RWWA Stewards' Reports, include details of all recent queried performances by greyhounds Racing in Western Australia.

Mandurah	10/01/12	2	Stewards queried the improved performance of EUCLA CHARLIE which broke the race record for a maiden over 405m in a slick 22.52. The trainer Mr Andrew McLaren advised Stewards that he was totally surprised by EUCLA CHARLIE'S performance tonight although he did show some potential early in his career by running a 30.80 at Cannington. EUCLA CHARLIE has since failed to live up to that potential or progress and has been running only low 23's over the 405m at Mandurah. Mr McLaren did reason that the track was in ideal condition tonight as he was racing between the Birthday Cup Heats and Final which would have contributed to EUCLA CHARLIE'S quick time but not fully explain it. EUCLA CHARLIE will continue to race over 405m at Mandurah. A urine sample was taken for analysis.
Cannington	15/10/11	1	Stewards queried the apparent poor performance of HOW GOODS THAT in Race 1. Mr D Hobby explained to the Stewards that the greyhound was up in grade and also received minor interference during the run. The greyhound was examined by the Veterinary Surgeon which revealed a strained monkey muscle and subsequently was stood down for 7 days. No further action was taken but a similar performance in the future may result in the greyhound being sent back to trial. A urine sample was taken for analysis.
