

TOMMY TOO GOOD IN SPRING GIFT

Tommy Shelby was once again too good for his opposition as he added the Spring Gift (520m) to his list of conquests at Cannington last Saturday.

The Steve Withers-trained sensation had no problems handling 'the lemon' as he speared to the front out of the boxes and established his supremacy early in the race.

Runner-up Fernando Star produced a cheeky run and stuck with the leader for a large part of the race but Tommy Shelby was always in control.

Tommy Shelby surged across the finish line to score by two lengths in a race record time of 29.60.

The blue phenom extended his winning sequence to five and he has now saluted in 18 of 24 career starts for more than \$180,000 in stakes.

His next target will be the WA Bred Championship before a possible crack at the Million Dollar Chase in Sydney.

PROCESSED DISCRETIONARY GRADE DROP

RADAR GUNN- Previous Grades: Provincial Middle Distance Grade 4 & Country Middle Distance Grade 4, City Distance Grade 3.

RADAR GUNN has not raced since 14 November 2019, due to a major hock injury.

RADAR GUNN has been downgraded to Provincial Middle Distance Grade 5 & Country Middle Distance Grade 5, City Distance Grade 5. Its Sprint grades remain the same at Grade 5 (2 to win).



TRIALS – NO CASH PAYMENT AT TRIALS

Trial Supervisors are no longer able to accept cash during Public Trial sessions as payment for trials. Cash payments have been identified as an audit risk.

Public Trials need to be paid for when booking using a credit or debit card. Cash payments will only be accepted at the Mandurah Reception or at the Welshpool Office at 2 Adrian St, Welshpool during weekday working hours.

Trial Supervisors will record any adjustments to the trials booked versus trials completed and if necessary record any credits or money owing.



MILLION DOLLAR CHASE - PARTICIPATION OF INTERSTATE GREYHOUNDS

Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission (**"GWIC"**) has announced the protocols that will be applied to all interstate greyhounds that are planning to compete in the Million Dollar Chase (**"MDC"**) series.



These protocols will be bought in so that the Commission can regulate the movement of greyhounds intending to participate in the upcoming MDC series.

The GWIC Million Dollar Chase interstate greyhound protocols are as follows:

1. From 28 August 2020, the Commission requires that all interstate trainers and/or owners with any greyhound that they intend to transfer to a New South Wales (**"NSW"**) registered trainer in order to nominate that greyhound for any event in the MDC series, including any supporting advertised Feature events, complete a "Million Dollar Chase – Interstate Trainer Transfer" form prior to the transfer occurring.
2. This form is to be provided at least three (3) business days before the transfer, or intended transfer, of the greyhound to a NSW registered trainer; and
3. The notification must be made through the attached MDC notification form, and is to be sent via email to registration@gwic.nsw.gov.au; and
4. A kennel notification must also be submitted within three (3) business days of the greyhound coming into the custody of a NSW registered trainer receiving the greyhound/s.
