WILL DERBY FALL TO DOMINO?

In-form chaser Domino Mac stormed into favouritism for this Friday night's Mandurah Derby final (490m) at Tabtouch Park Mandurah following a blistering performance to win his heat last weekend.

The white and blue speedster produced a scorching effort to equal the track record run of 27.02 set by Zack Monelli almost exactly a year earlier.

Domino Mac established the tone early with a brilliant jump out of the boxes to capture the lead.

Sudoku Shelby, a greyhound that came into the race on the back of five straight wins, also began well and gave hot pursuit but at no stage in the race could he make ground on the leader.

Domino Mac maintained a cracking pace on the lure and then dropped off Sudoku Shelby in the home straight to score by more than six lengths.

After a sluggish start to his career Domino Mac has been humming over the past couple of months for trainer Kylie McLennan, who bred and owns the dog with her husband Ron.

Domino Mac has won his last six starts on the Mandurah circuit over the 405m and 490m journeys.

The other heat winners were Earn The Answers, Got The Swagger (pictured) and Fearless Eagles.

Former Victorian chaser Earn The Answers impressed in his first start in WA for new trainer David Hobby with an all-the-way victory from box one.

Earn The Answers fired to the front at box rise and then blew his rivals away to score in 27.16.

Reminder that all Losing Sequence races are selected based on the longest losing sequence down to the shortest. Order of Choice ranking is only used to split greyhounds with the same losing sequence.

A minimum of 6 starts since last win to be eligible to nominate.

Wait time from passed pre-assessment to entry into GAP:	If greyhound has an up-to-date, C5 vaccination we can take on the day if we have space.

Please note: All greyhounds must be pre-assessed before entering GAP.
A greyhound must not have raced 14 days prior to the date it is booked for pre-assessment.
