## JAYVILLE TOO SLICK IN CANNING SHOW CUP

Jayville Slick made a triumphant return to the WA by taking out the Canning Show Cup (600m) at Cannington last Saturday.

The Krystal Shinners-trained chaser was having his first run in the state since the start of May and he immediately found the form that saw him win six races and make the final of Galaxy in his previous stints over here.

After landing near the tail of the field Jayville Slick (pictured) pushed forward in the early and middle stages of the race to sit at the tail of the leading Vice Grip as they hit the final turn.

Jayville Slick scooted along the rail in the home straight to nail Vice Grip on the line by head in 34.70.

Saturday also saw the running of four heats of the Group 3 Young Stars Classic (520m).

Unsee This, from Shayne Williams' kennels, qualified as the fastest runner after he toppled Momentum in their heat clash.

Momentum captured the initial lead but with the benefit of the inside running Unsee This edged ahead as they rounded into the back straight.

The pair battled it out for the remainder of the journey with Unsee This able to hold out his rival to score by half a length in 29.53.

Williams also collected another heat winner when Tiger Town won his heat in 30.08.

Panadero Opal (29.73) and Amplified (29.79) were the other heat winners.

A minimum of 6 starts since last win to be eligible to nominate.

Just as a reminder, greyhounds can only be booked in when they are ready to retire (via a race name or ear brands).

Note: Trainers when you arrive at the GAP property for a pre-assessment can you please report to the GAP office to let the staff know you are there.

Wait time from passed pre-assessment to entry into GAP:	If greyhound has an up-to-date C5 vaccination we can take on the day if we have space.
Please note: All greyhounds must be pre-assessed before entering GAP. A greyhound must not have raced 14 days prior to the date it is booked for pre-assessment.

## OUTS TO DROP A GRADE

As previously advertised at the last Grading Review Panel meeting the Outs to Drop a Grade policy was reviewed.

It was decided to implement a system that applies across all 3 classes of racing where Grades 1,2,3 have 2 outs to drop a grade and Grade 4 have 3 outs to drop. (Country Grade 5 will remain 3 outs to drop back to a Grade 6).

The final stages of OzChase testing is being competed. With an activation date being imminent.

### Greyhound Injury Full Recovery Scheme (GIFRS)

Under GIFRS the ownership of a greyhound sustaining an eligible injury at a race meeting, or official trial, is transferred to RWAA's Greyhounds as Pets (GAP) program, following which the injured greyhound is transported to emergency care and all associated costs of surgery and rehabilitation are covered by RWAA. If suitable, the greyhound will then be rehomed post recovery through GAP's standard processes.

This scheme complements the Greyhound Injury Surgery Rebate (GISR), where RWAA offers a financial contribution, for eligible cases, to help the trainer and owner pay for the costs of veterinary care.
