## VICE GRIP WINS PHOENIX MATCH RACE

Vice Grip is on the way to The Phoenix.

The Adam Smithson-trained chaser out muscled his opponent Fernando Star in the Match Race over 520m at Cannington last Saturday and booked his spot in the inaugural \$1 million dollar event at Meadows later this month.

Fernando Star began well and jumped to the front briefly but was quickly overhauled as Vice Grip clicked up into top gear.

Vice Grip powered to the front to establish his authority on the race and while Fernando Star battled on gamely to keep the leader honest, he couldn't make inroads into the margin.

Vice Grip rattled home to score by more than two lengths in 29.54.

In other racing Valachi and Mambo Monelli won their respective heats of the Anniversary Cup (520m).

Valachi made it back-to-back wins when he bested runner-up West On Brae to win by two lengths in 29.82.

In the other heat Mambo Monelli bounced straight to the lead and was never headed before scoring over Torza by a length and half in 29.74.

One night earlier at Mandurah the two Express Stake heats (405m) were taken out by Submariner (22.58) and City Monelli (22.63).



## SCHEDULED CANNINGTON TRACK MAINTENANCE

Please note the Cannington Track is scheduled to be deep raked next Tuesday morning December 14 as part of routine Track Maintenance.

It will be deep raked to a depth of 70mm. The track will then be bladed and rolled to reconstitute the racing surface. The track surface will be in good order for Public Trials on Tuesday evening.

Reminder that all Losing Sequence races are selected based on the longest losing sequence down to the shortest. Order of Choice ranking is only used to split greyhounds with the same losing sequence.

A minimum of 6 starts since last win to be eligible to nominate.

## GAP UPDATE

Just as a reminder, greyhounds can only be booked in when they are ready to retire (via a race name or ear brands).

Note: Trainers when you arrive at the GAP property for a pre-assessment can you please report to the GAP office to let the staff know you are there.

Next available pre-assessment:	<b>Tuesday 19/04/2022 and Friday 22/04/2022</b>
Wait time from passed pre-assessment to entry into GAP:	If greyhound has an up-to-date C5 vaccination we can take on the day if we have space.
Please note: All greyhounds must be pre-assessed before entering GAP. A greyhound must not have raced 14 days prior to the date it is booked for pre-assessment.
